Everyone has muddled and confusing feelings about cancer. We can help.

Cavendish Cancer Care offers a specialist service to children and young people up to the age of 18 whose lives have been affected by cancer.

This includes those who have had cancer themselves, as well as those who have been affected by the illness within the family. The service also works with young people who are bereaved for any reason.

As well as offering one-to-one sessions to the young people, our therapists also offer advice and support to parents and guardians who are looking for guidance in supporting young people affected by a cancer diagnosis, and in managing change in the family.

Our Young People's Service is provided by a team of experienced therapists, who use a wide range of approaches to enable young people to explore their difficulties and find appropriate solutions.
