We are an independent charity and not part of the NHS.

The care, support and counselling that cancer patients and their families receive is provided on a free of charge basis, and this would not be possible without people like **you** fundraising for us.

If you're doing a sponsored challenge, it's really easy to fundraise online as well as in person. You can set up a Just Giving page, and Cavendish will happily help you spread the word!

Every penny you raise will go to support local people affected by cancer.

You could provide:

£27 could pay for an acupuncture session for a cancer patient to relieve nausea

£265 could provide a programme of specialist support for a child affected by cancer

£380 could provide one complete course of therapy for one person.
