What is it?

Squids In is a charity challenge especially for students. It's your chance to put on your dream event, pursue that business idea, or do anything else you feel like doing. We'll give you £50 to get started, and your job is to raise as much money as possible from your venture, in four weeks. This money will go to Cavendish Cancer Care, to support local cancer patients and their families.

How does it work?

1.) Send a CV and 250 words on why you want to get involved to Claudia on **C.Down@cavcare.org.uk**. Tell us when you want to start your challenge - we're flexible, so choose any time frame that suits you (e.g. a weekend, two weeks, etc.)

You can enter as an individual, a pair, or a group of up to 4 people.

2.) If you're successful, we'll invite you/your group in to meet with the team here at Cavendish. You'll receive training and expert support to help make your idea a reality.

3.) We'll give you £50 to get you started. You then have four weeks to generate as much income as possible.

4.) Off you go!
